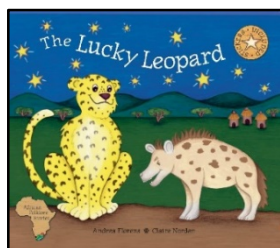

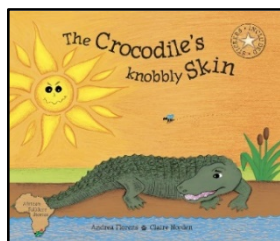


The Lucky Leopard

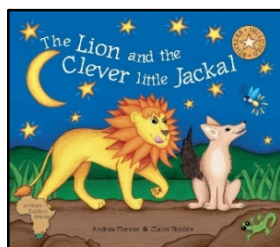


The Crocodile's Knobbly Skin

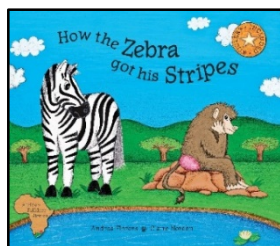


The Lion and the Clever Little Jackal

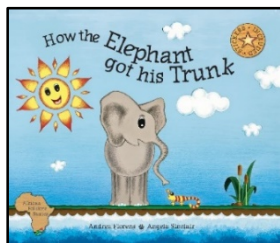


How the Zebra Got His Stripes

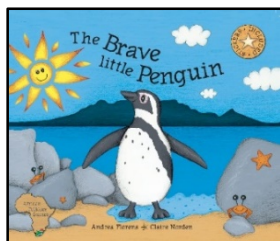

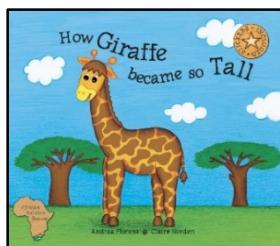

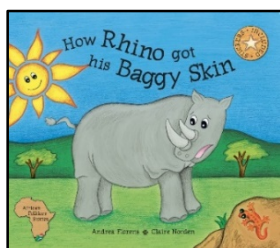


How Giraffe Became So Tall

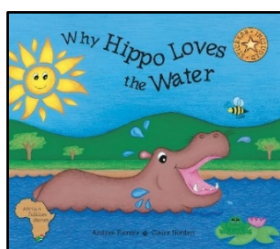
