



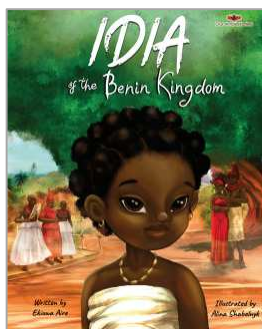
At Our Ancestories, we know that there is a deep divide between the truth of African history and the common understanding of it.

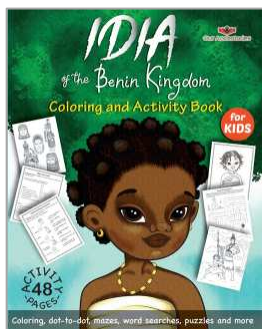
Idia of the Benin Kingdom

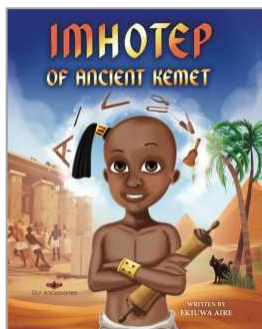

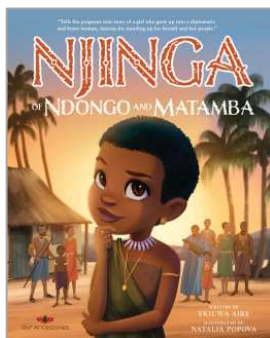
Imhotep of Ancient Kemet

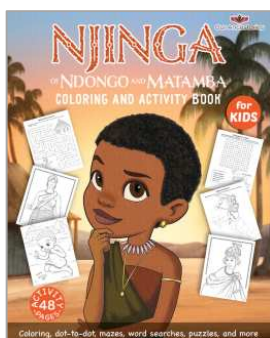
Njinga of Ndongo and Matamba

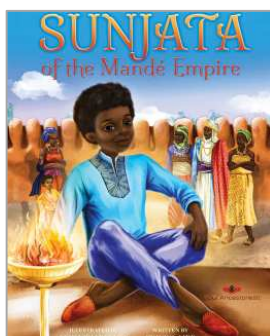
Njinga of Ndongo & Matamba Coloring and Activity Book
